CHAPTER 2. PROVIDING EDUCATIONAL PROJECTS

Between the bright flashes of the (un)conferences the hard work is going on. Here are some initiatives that educators choose not for show but because they see their efficiency.



The World Global Dignity Day – a training course in a dialogue format and an event for teachers and students, that is celebrated annually in over 70 countries at the same time in October.

We translated into Ukrainian and adapted all the methodological materials, then tested them during 2015 and 2016. Now they are all in free access to use for all educators.

Couching for teachers from Coursera is one of the top courses for professional development of teachers created by MOOC platform – Coaching Teachers: Promoting Changes that Stick. The course was translated and adapted in Ukrainian by our team. The course helps to understand how to give good feedback and support for professional development as well as how to implement this in practice.

What young people think is reflected in Global Shapers Annual Survey 2016 that is the world largest study of values, beliefs and difficulties young people face today. The survey was initiated by World Economic Forum. In cooperation with Kharkiv Hub of Global Shapers Community we translated the survey questionnaire using gender-sensitive language and surveyed Ukrainian women and men aged from 18 to 35, teachers in particular.

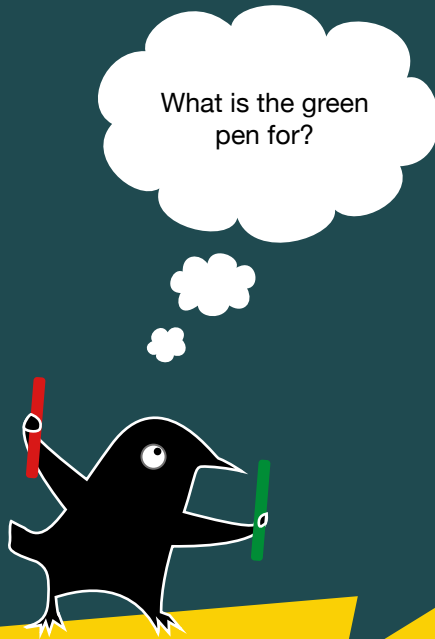

The New Ukrainian School is the title of the competences oriented reform of the secondary school education. We actively participated in designing of the two important documents: The Conceptual Grounds of Reforming Secondary School and The Basics of Education Standards. At all (un)conferences we used so-called “reformometer” for discussing the changes in groups of teachers.

Now we have more opportunities to make the voice of teachers more powerful due to participating in the work of Hromadska Rada (Public Council) and project groups of the Ministry of Education and Science. Oleksandr Elkin and Olena Malakhova are advisors to the Minister of Education and Science of Ukraine

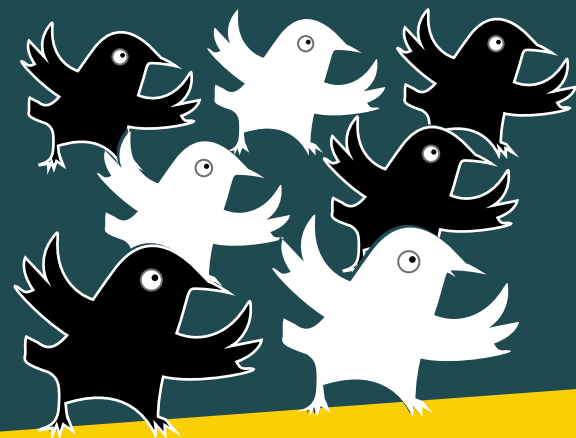

The anti-discrimination expertise of the educational school content is being implemented for the first time in Ukraine and is mandatory for drafts of the school textbooks (prior to their publication) and school curricula. We want children to grow in the space of equality and unbiased attitude towards people by age, disability, gender, nationality and any other characteristics. This work is carried out in cooperation with KRONA NGO and the Educational Content Modernization Institute.

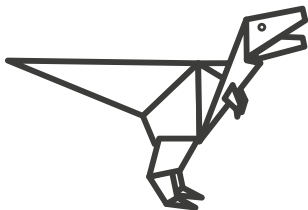

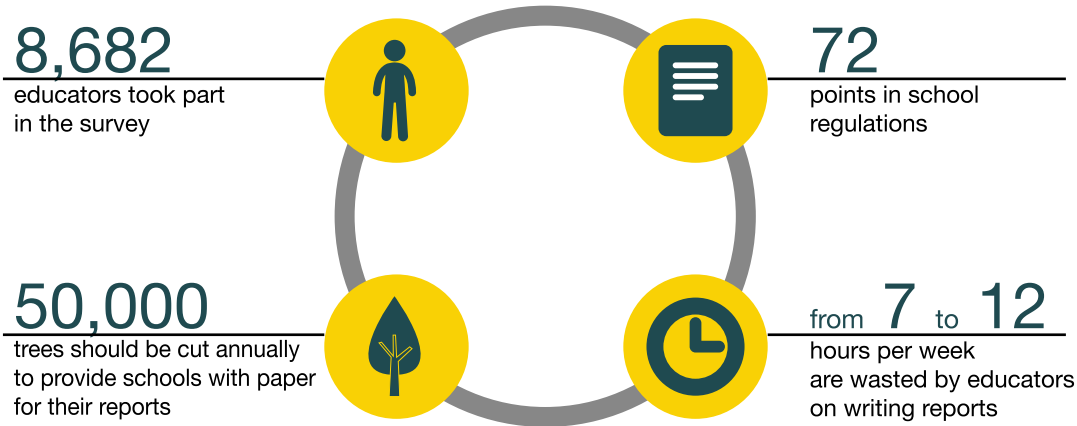


TO SUBMIT AN URGENT REPORT



Children and Papers: How to achieve balance at school – a large-scale survey devoted to analyzing school bureaucracy and outlining ways to overcome it. In particular, it was found out that time which is now wasted on excessive paperwork would be otherwise spent on the children and personal professional development.

As a result of the public discussion of this study, a working group on de-bureaucracy was created at the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, and it is working with three priorities: to reduce reporting on educational activities, to free teachers from registration of school-age children, and to develop a new manual for paper work.

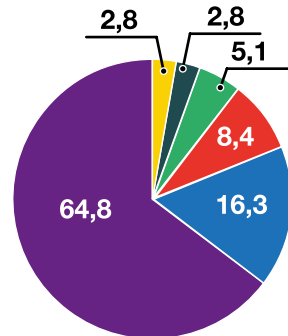

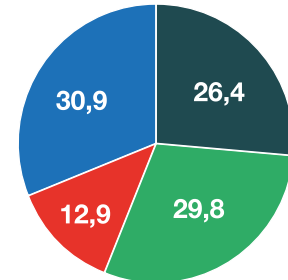

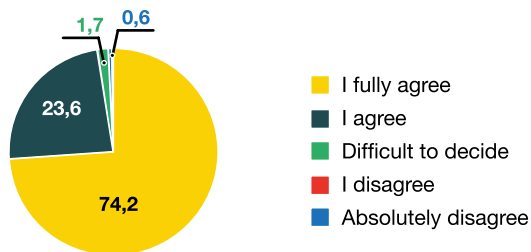

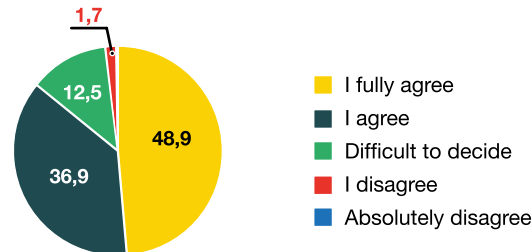

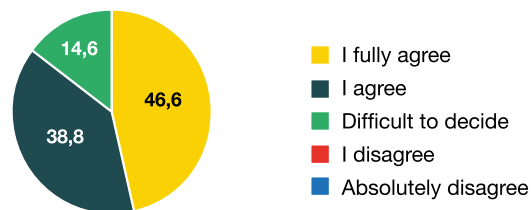

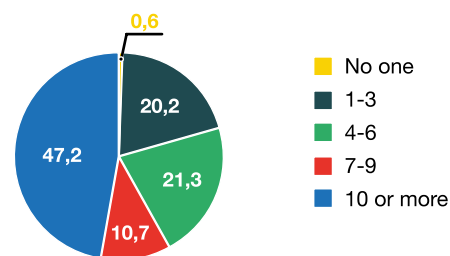

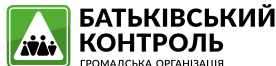
The non-governmental organization EdCamp Ukraine is financially and institutionally independent.
